

FANS GRANT PROGRAM (GUIDELINES) PROJECT ASSISTANCE FOR INDIVIDUAL ARTISTS

Available to North & West Vancouver

Artists of ALL Disciplines

PURPOSE

This annual cash grant is intended to assist emerging and established North and West Vancouver artist(s) of all ages who are interested in developing their practice.

GRANT

Funds for this grant are generated through the investment income earned from the FANS Endowment or through private donations. All applications will be evaluated for eligibility for all FANS grants including the Ruth Payne Emerging Artist Grant and the new Indigenous Arts Excellence Grant. Historically awarded project grants have averaged between \$1,000 - \$3,500.

ELIGIBLITY

Applying artists must:

- 1. Be currently active in their art discipline and intend to continue developing their practice.
- 2. Be residents of North or West Vancouver or have a majority of their creative work take place there.
- 3. Propose projects that require no longer than one year to complete.

* FANS Board members and their families are not eligible to apply.

CATEGORIES

Applicants may apply for support under one of the following categories:

- Artistic Production: Supports the creation of new artwork being produced with the goal of eventual public presentation.
- **Marketing Development:** Supports the development of an artist's career. This may include the creation of marketing materials and/or other tools to help promote their work, skills or creative services. Examples of eligible activity include: website development, portfolios, social networks, music recording, video recording, etc.

- Artistic Research or Professional Development: Supports independent research at a key time in the artistic practice of the applicant. The proposed activity must demonstrate the capacity to advance or expand the artist's practice. Examples of eligible activity: educational course, artist mentorship, arts conference, specialized research, etc.
- Indigenous Arts: FANS will provide up to \$1000 in grants specifically for Indigenous Arts Excellence in 2023. Our organization is committed to addressing the Truth and Reconciliation Commission's 94 Calls to Action. We feel this step is one action of many toward reconciliation and decolonization. The jury for this funding will prioritize Indigenous Artists and their voices.
- Other: Individual artists may be interested in support for creative activity that does not fit into one of the above noted categories. Artists in this situation may submit an application but must elaborate on the specifics of the artistic work and the outcomes for which they seek.

ADJUDICATION

The Adjudication Panel will carefully review each application taking into consideration the following:

- 1. Compliance with the eligibility criteria.
- 2. Documentation of the applicant's most recent artwork (digital photos, recordings, etc.).
- 3. Funding request, projected goals, and anticipated outcomes.

FINAL REPORTING:

Upon completion of their projects the successful applicants are required to report back to FANS with a written confirmation of project completion including photos and a brief 1-2 minute point and shoot video, promoting/documenting the project. More details will be provided to grant recipients.

INSTRUCTIONS TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION:

- 1. Complete the application form.
- 2. Provide documentation of recently completed artwork (images, recordings, writing, etc.).
- 3. Include both reference forms completed and signed.
